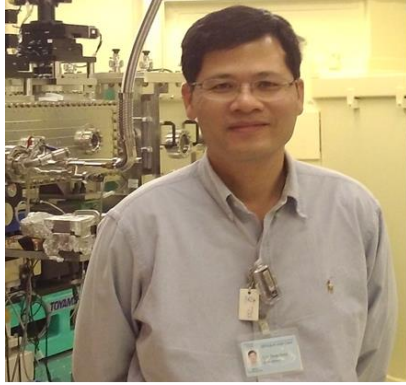


Deng-Sung Lin

He has been investigating on the surface and interfacial atomic and electronic structures of semiconductors by using scanning tunneling microscopy and synchrotron radiation photoemission spectroscopy at Synchrotron Radiation Center, Wisconsin, the National Synchrotron Light Source, NY, the National Synchrotron Radiation Research Center, Taiwan and Super Photon Ring-8, Japan. He is currently also the Director of Center of Innovation Incubator.
